

RINGING ON HOLT ISLAND 27th JUNE 2019

This was a short session using a small number of nets, the morning was mostly overcast with a little sun and breeze towards the end.

The catch was aimed at Warblers but the number caught was not as high as hoped, however a number of young Chiffchaffs, Blackcap and a Sedge Warbler were caught. The number of young Robins is still higher than previous years.

Some of Great Tits and Blue Tits from the Island boxes were re-trapped, including 3 Great Tits from box 10, 2 Great Tits from Box 23 and one from Box 22, also Blue Tits from Boxes 19 and 3.

One of the Blackbirds was ringed as a juvenile in July 2014.

A good number of butterflies came out with the sun including Painted Lady (recently arrived from North Africa), Commas, Brown Argos, Meadow Brown and Red Admiral. A Cinnabar moth was also seen
